The 66 credits of English major courses constitute the identity of the BA in English Studies degree. These are the courses that distinguish the BA in English Studies from other degree majors in the University. English major courses concentrate on literature in English and linguistics with an interest in English.

Within the English major courses a three-year graduated series of compulsory courses totalling 36 credits develop a foundation in English literature and linguistics. Thirty credits of senior courses that pursue more specialized interests within the larger field of English Studies are offered in the third and fourth years of the degree.

General Education, Language and Skills, and Community and Peer Education courses are governed by University-wide undergraduate degree regulations. General Education Electives, distributed over the four years of the English Studies curriculum, cover areas specified by the University. Language and Skills (15 credits) are courses taken outside the major. Details on the regulations concerning these courses can be found on the Registry webpage.

Free Electives may be taken from courses offered by any undergraduate degree programme of the University of Macau. (Restrictions may apply).
